VARIETAL 100% Petit Sirah

(a cross pollination of Syrah & Peloursin Noir, first discovered in Montpellier by French botanist, Francois Durif in 1860)

### TASTING NOTE

Full-bodied, exquisitely deep colour combined with complex, silky tannins, and succulent bright plum fruit.

## VINEYARD

A bush-vine Petit Sirah planted in weathered granite soil, from Fairview Farm, just outside Malmesbury.

### WINEMAKING

Hand harvested Petit Sirah with 30% whole bunches was cold soaked for 2 days before wild fermentation in opentop stainless-steel tanks; followed by a two-week extended skin contact. The wine was pressed into 300L older French oak barrels to mature for 8 months before bottling.

### SERVE & AGEING

Best served at 14 to 18 °C, this wine will develop in complexity over the next 3 - 5 years.
